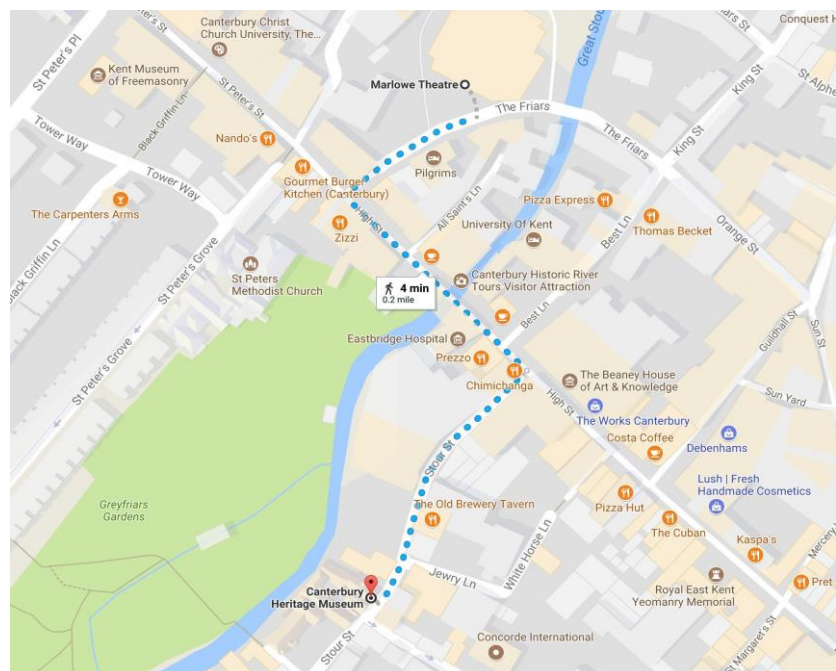

Coming soon...

The Marlowe's next community production is *Return Of The Unknown*, an 18-month performance project working alongside groups from across Kent. The project seeks to discover what the First World War means to us in Kent today, revealing what we have forgotten and returning the 'Unknown' to public consciousness. The work will culminate in what will be The Marlowe's most ambitious community production yet, in November 2018, to mark the 100 year anniversary of the armistice at Dover Admiralty Pier - the site of the repatriation of The Unknown Warrior.
