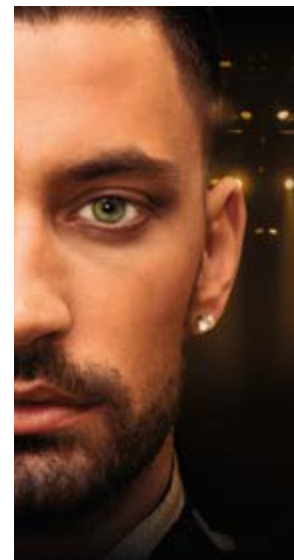

An Introduction to Movie Screenwriting

Have you ever wanted to write a screenplay? Could you be the next Spike Lee, Greta Gerwig or Jean-Luc Godard? Have you got a brilliant new rom-com, horror film, gritty urban drama, or a surreal masterpiece you want to see up on screen, but don't know where to begin?

Over eight weeks, you will learn the craft of writing an original screenplay through discussion of a range of films from across the world and across the decades. You will be guided to write a screenplay, alongside practical sessions in which you will be invited to make a short digital film of your own.

Write a Team Play

British Sign-Language interpreted Performances An interpreter stands on, or aside the stage and interprets the spoken word and sound effects of the performance for d/Deaf customers who use BSL.



Captioned Performances Text is displayed on a screen, it includes the words spoken by the performers as well as character names and sound effects.



Relaxed Performances Ideal for anyone who prefers a more relaxed environment, including those on the autistic spectrum, with helpful changes made to the show and auditorium.



Chilled Performances A more casual theatre-going experience. It is okay to walk in-and-out and rules on noise are more relaxed. They do not include any changes to the show.

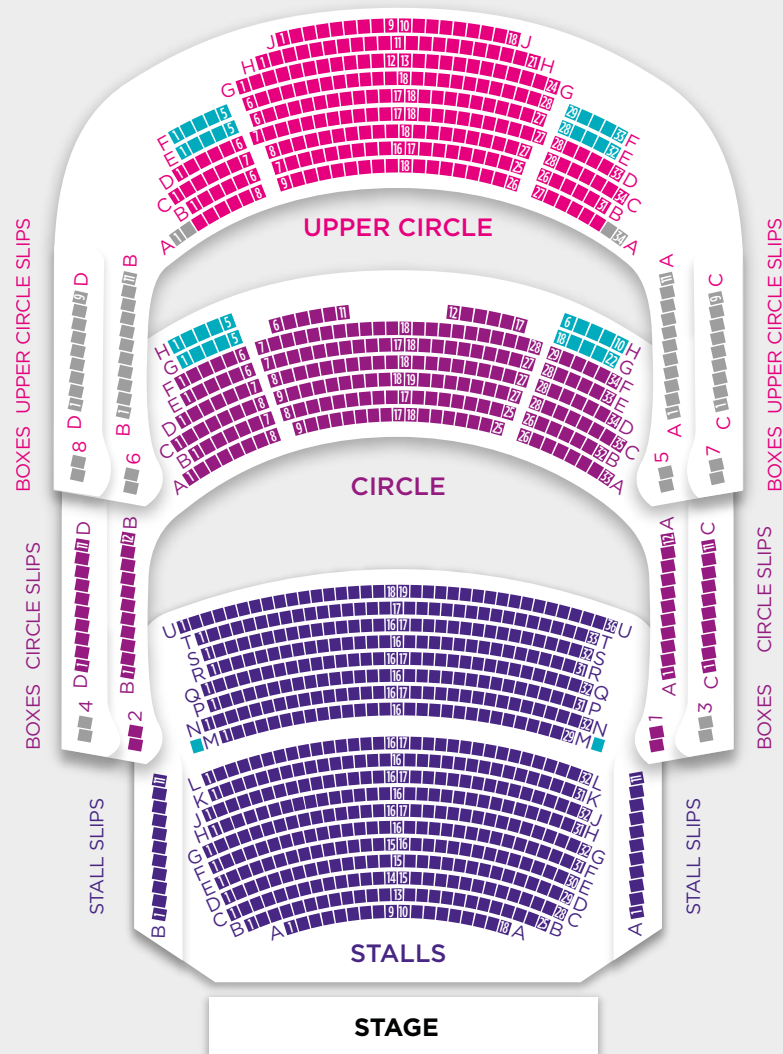
