WELCOME TO OUR SPRING SEASON

Welcome to our spring brochure, packed with theatre, dance, orchestral music, comedy and musicals. There's a a great season of theatre-going ahead, to see you through the winter months and into the spring, including a very special birthday season for our resident symphony orchestra, the Philharmonia, who will celebrate their 80th birthday.

We're also celebrating a whole series of firsts here at the Marlowe. Huge congratulations to our first cohort of students from the Marlowe Academy of Performing Arts (our partnership with East Kent College). All 19 of them passed their two-year Level 3 diploma course in Performing and Production Arts, with six of them achieving a distinction.

Our investment in new writing in the region and beyond culminated in our first *Writers' Room Festival* in August, showcasing 11 plays (eight of which were developed by local writers through our writers' programmes) and providing workshops, industry insights and networking opportunities for regional writers and theatre-makers. Over 800 people took part and 37 professional actors brought the plays to life. We plan to hold this event annually.

And last but not least, our first ever home-produced Main House touring production, *The Party Girls* by Amy Rosenthal, premiered here in September and garnered over a dozen 4 star and 5 star reviews as it toured the country, playing to nearly 20,000 people. Our producing wing, Marlowe Theatre Productions, will build on this great start, producing large-scale drama every year here in Kent, providing jobs and a host of vocational training opportunities and taking high quality theatre, made in Kent, out across the UK.
